

Cleaning Guide

General Cleaning Recommendation:

Prompt cleaning is always recommended. Recommended cleaning steps are listed by type of stain.

Regular Cleaning and Maintenance (Dirt, Dust, Grime):

Clean the soiled area with mild soap and water, then rinse with fresh water and wipe dry with a clean cloth

Food Stains / Oils (Ketchup, Chocolate, Coffee, Tea, Juice):

Wipe affected area with a soft cloth or soft bristle brush using a non-abrasive cleaner, for example Formula 409 or Fantastik. Rinse with fresh water and wipe dry.

Healthcare (Blood, Urine, Betadine, Disinfectant):

Clean the soiled area with a 20% solution of Household Bleach and water. Rinse the cleaned area with fresh water after applying the bleach solution.

Difficult Stains (Eye Shadow/Mascara, Lipstick, Crayon, Grease, Mustard):

Clean the soiled area with 50% solution of Isopropyl Alcohol (Rubbing Alcohol) and water. Alternately, use a 25% solution of Bleach and water. Rinse the cleaned area with fresh water after applying the alcohol solution (bleach solution).

Denim Dye Transfer

Denim dye can typically removed with a 70% dilution of isopropyl and water.

Note: Removal of indigo dye, particularly from wet jeans, may vary depending on the type of denim. Full removal is not guaranteed.

Ink Stains (Ballpoint Pen, Permanent Marker, Paint):

Rub the marked area with Undiluted Isopropyl Alcohol (Rubbing Alcohol). Rinse the cleaned area with fresh water promptly after applying the alcohol. Note: To achieve the best results, it is recommended to clean the stain immediately.

Note:

- The use of commercial vinyl conditioners and protectants is NOT RECOMMENDED.
- This product may withstand the regular use of commercial cleaners and disinfectants not listed above. It is recommended to test the cleaners on a sample prior to use.
